PROFILE:




Not receiving much of a "talk" from his parents or school, his sex education is self-taught, from the internet, and certainly not comprehensive.












Derpy Danny


BARRIERS

PROFILE:



BARRIERS

Limited male birth control options impacts his ability to take responsibility for his actions and to manage his fertility as he sees fit.



BARRIERS

Lack of dialogue with partners about experiences with contraception limits his understanding of their challenges, and the empathy he feels towards them in this regard.





He definitely wants to avoid experiencing an unintended pregnancy, and generally communicates with partners to ensure one of them is contracepting, but is frustrated by his lack of options.






MOTIVATIONS

He suffers from a pervasive lack of trust in women, and is seeking better, more effective contraception due to this.





They are currently contracepting, but would love more options that they could take advantage of.





BARRIERS


He wishes that there were more male contraceptives that provide a range of options (e.g., method and duration of action) similar to what women have as he is hesitant to commit to sterilization right now.





Wait, What? Waylan




PROFILE:




MOTIVATIONS

If better options of male contraception were available, he would not be averse to using them even if he is not readily seeking them out currently.


BARRIERS




MOTIVATIONS

He is comfortable in or out of a relationship and enjoys sex, but wishes there were more contraceptive options for men; he does not like having to rely on condoms.




Protective Patrice




PROFILE:




MOTIVATIONS




MOTIVATIONS
